What's it like living in a safe house?

Domestic abuse affects some men too.

Male victims, like female victims, may live with domestic abuse for years before they tell anyone or seek help.

You do not have to put up with it.

You can escape from a violent relationship and build a new life for yourself. **You have a choice.**

- at night and at weekends we have an emergency advice line
- contact the police and they will help you to get to a safe house
- if you need medical attention go to a Hospital Casualty Department
- if possible, take with you your own front door key
- bring clothing for you
- please bring proof of income and identity with you
- keep our telephone number in a safe place.

- This house has a secret location.
- The house is clean and well equipped.
- You have a key to your own room and the front door.
- You cook your own food.
- There will be support for you from a key worker.
- You have your own privacy.
- There will be other men in similar circumstances to whom you can talk.

How can we help?

During your stay we will provide emotional and practical support. We will help you with your benefits, your legal options and your housing options.
